2025 Targa Tasmania - Road Closure Guides 15 – 21 November 2025

2025 marks the 31st running of Targa Tasmania—the ultimate tarmac rally that brings together entrants, supporters, spectators, and media from across Australia and around the world. This year's event will feature more than 200 of the world's most desirable classic, sports, and grand touring cars, delivering a multi-million boost to our Tasmanian economy.

Targa Tasmania is not conducted within a fixed stadium environment. Instead, the event takes place on closed public roads, requiring temporary closures of up to four hours. We sincerely appreciate the patience and understanding of local residents and communities who make it possible for this unique Tasmanian event to continue.

In the lead-up to the event, you may notice advisory road closure signage being installed, as well as public notices and advertisements appearing in The Examiner, The Advocate, and The Mercury. All relevant organisations—including bus, coach, and freight operators, emergency services, schools, and community groups—are being directly notified of closure times to help minimise disruption.

Every effort will be made to reduce delays and ensure roads reopen as soon as safely possible, with most expected to open earlier than the advertised time based on previous years' experience.

During the closure period, residents along the Targa stages will continue to have full access to emergency services. Police, fire, and ambulance teams are actively involved in the event and can respond rapidly should the need arise. In any emergency, please continue to dial 000 as normal.

We genuinely value the continued support of Tasmanian residents, visitors and local communities who help make Targa Tasmania possible.
